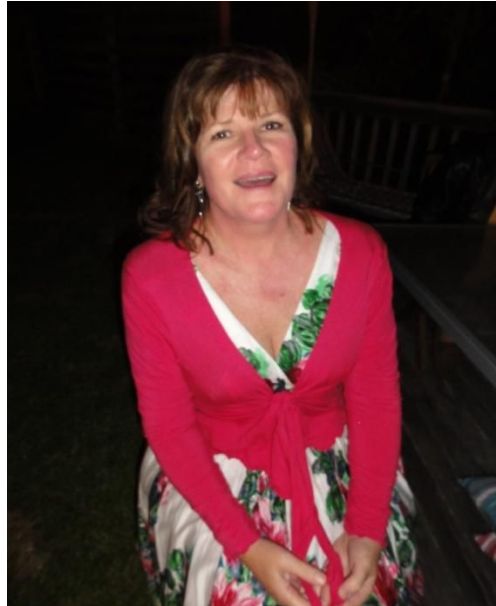


THE KATHY WALSH MEMORIAL SPONSORSHIP

The Kathy Walsh Memorial Sponsorship (KWMS) is open to all NAATI Paraprofessional level interpreters in Australia, and to interpreters in New Zealand who hold a Diploma in Sign Language Interpreting or Bachelor of Arts NZSL-English Interpreting, who attend as much PD as they are able to and improve their skill level in order to serve their communities.

I will fund The Kathy Walsh Memorial Sponsorship, to be established in conjunction with ASLIA, to provide two ASLIA National Conference or National Auslan Conference registrations (biennially) from 2014-2024.
