ANC2020 Keynote Speaker: Professor Alys Young



Professor Alys Young PhD, FAcSS is a social scientist who for the past 30 years has specialised in applied health and social care research concerning deaf people across the lifecourse. She has led numerous research studies focussing on health and wellbeing, the organisation, delivery and reform of services to promote equality, and is author of over 150 published works. She is Professor of Social Work at the University of Manchester, and leads the Social Research with Deaf People group, which is a sign bilingual team of deaf and hearing applied social scientists. She is particularly interested in the impact of professional behaviours and interactions on personal wellbeing, individual agency, and the (re)production of structural inequalities within service delivery. This interest extends to sign language interpreters as actors in resilient enabling change processes.




AASLIA is committed to making its conferences as sustainable as possible. We are always exploring new ways to do this.
