## "I FELT YUCK ABOUT THAT JOB": UNPICKING THE LAYERS OF DIFFICULT INTERPRETING

Brokering communication is sometimes difficult: unfamiliar or poorly delivered content, language and experiential differences, not knowing who we are interpreting to. People often have unrealistic expectations of our capacity to make a situation 'accessible'. Of course we may feel overstretched or ineffectual. In this workshop we will use the lens of pragmatics to think about how contextual conditions shape interpreting options and decisions.
