ASLIA supports the new Certification credentialing system of interpreters, which has recently been launched by NAATI.

ASLIA supports this new credentialing system, as it is one element that can contribute to ensuring high standards of practice and professionalism.

Interpreting agencies who partner with ASLIA also support the new NAATI credential changes and as such, preference will be given to practitioners who hold NAATI Certification as of 1 July 2018.

ASLIA strongly encourages practitioners currently holding NAATI Accreditation to transition to the new certification system. Certification requires practitioners to undertake continuing professional development, and to be accountable to ensure that enhancement of skill levels are firmly in place. This transition will set in motion a minimum standard of professional development practices, as seen with many other professions.
