- Currently there are 20,683 credentials across 179 languages awarded under the certification system. These are held by a total of 15,621 practitioners.

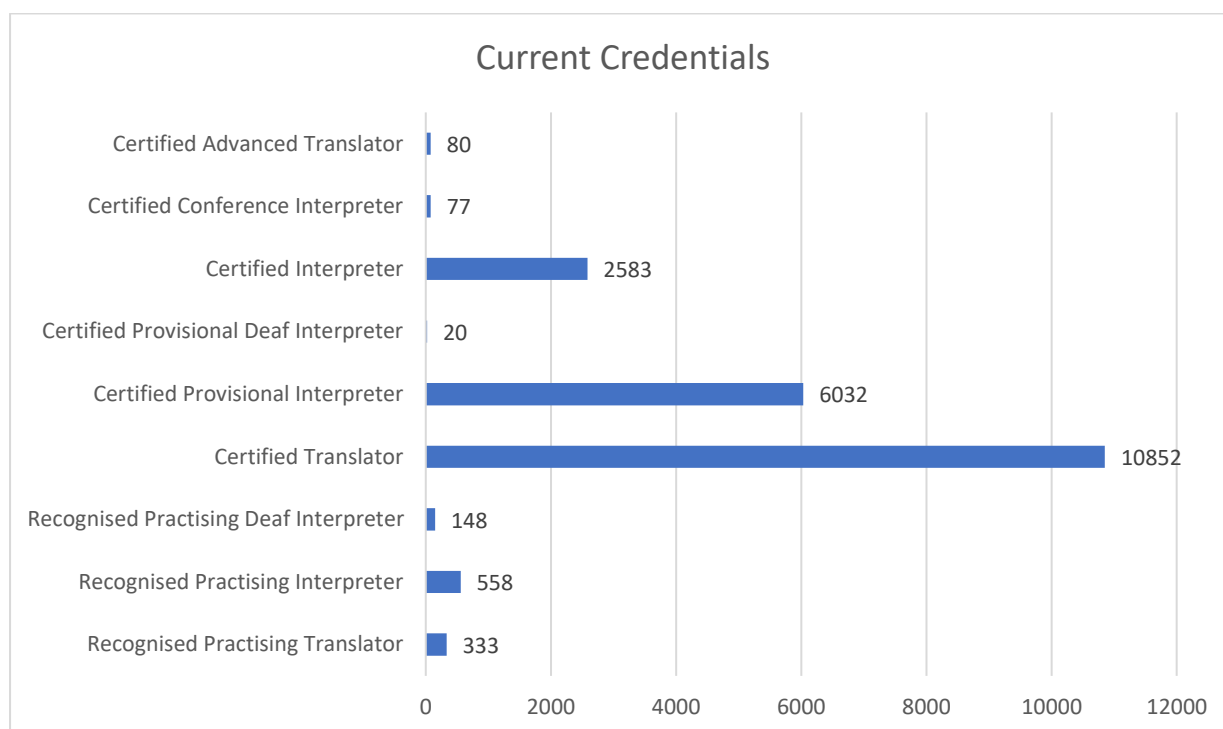


Figure 1 Breakdown of credentials awarded

- Credentials have been awarded in all Australian States and Territories, with 1019 credentials held by residents of countries other than Australia.

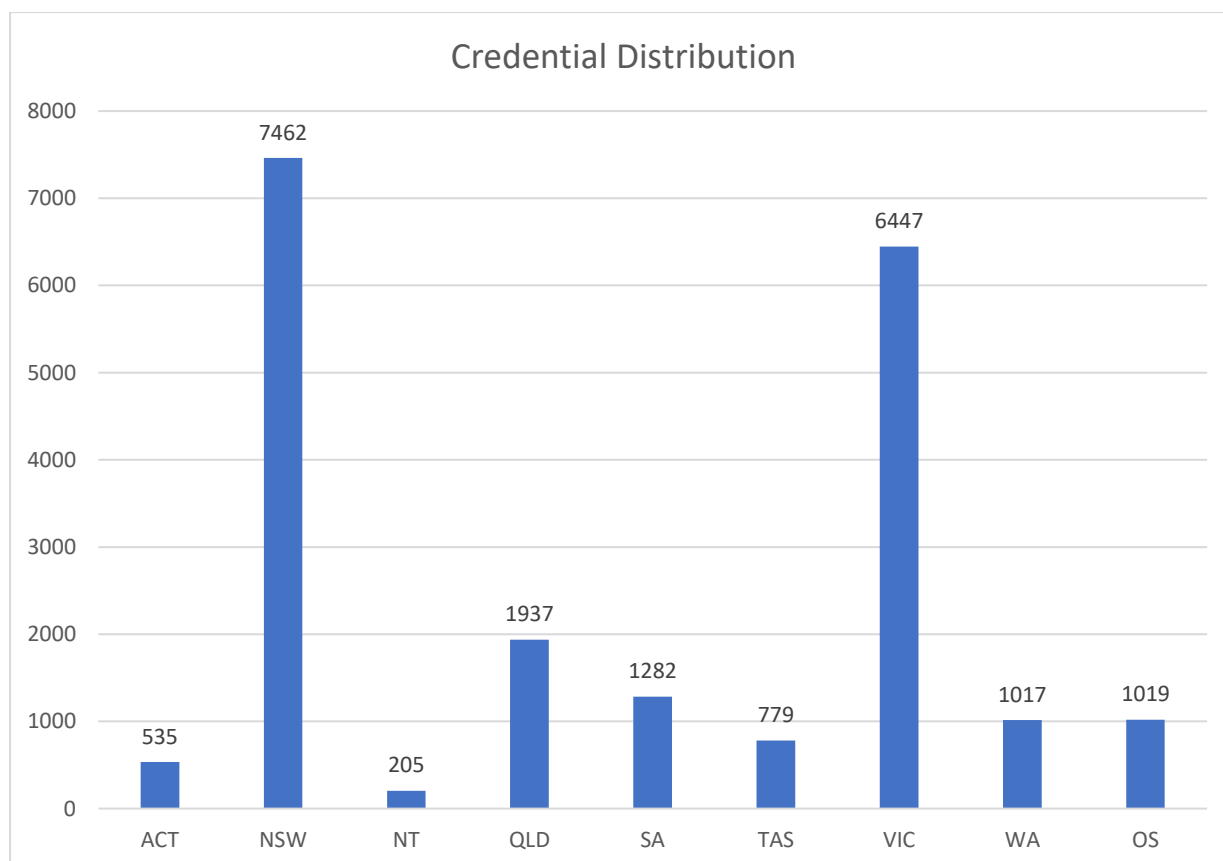


Figure 2 Credentials awarded by location

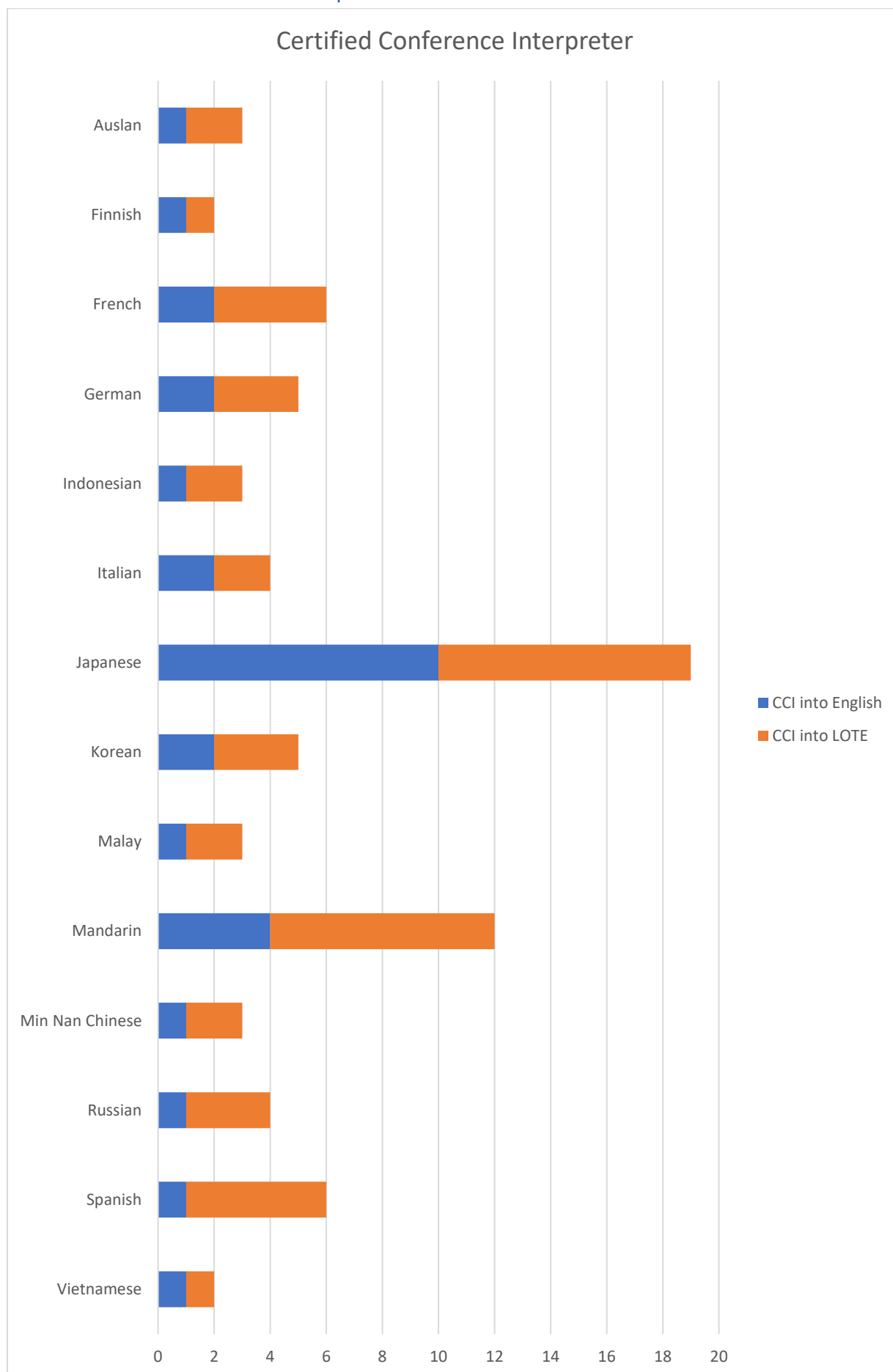


Figure 3 CCI credentials

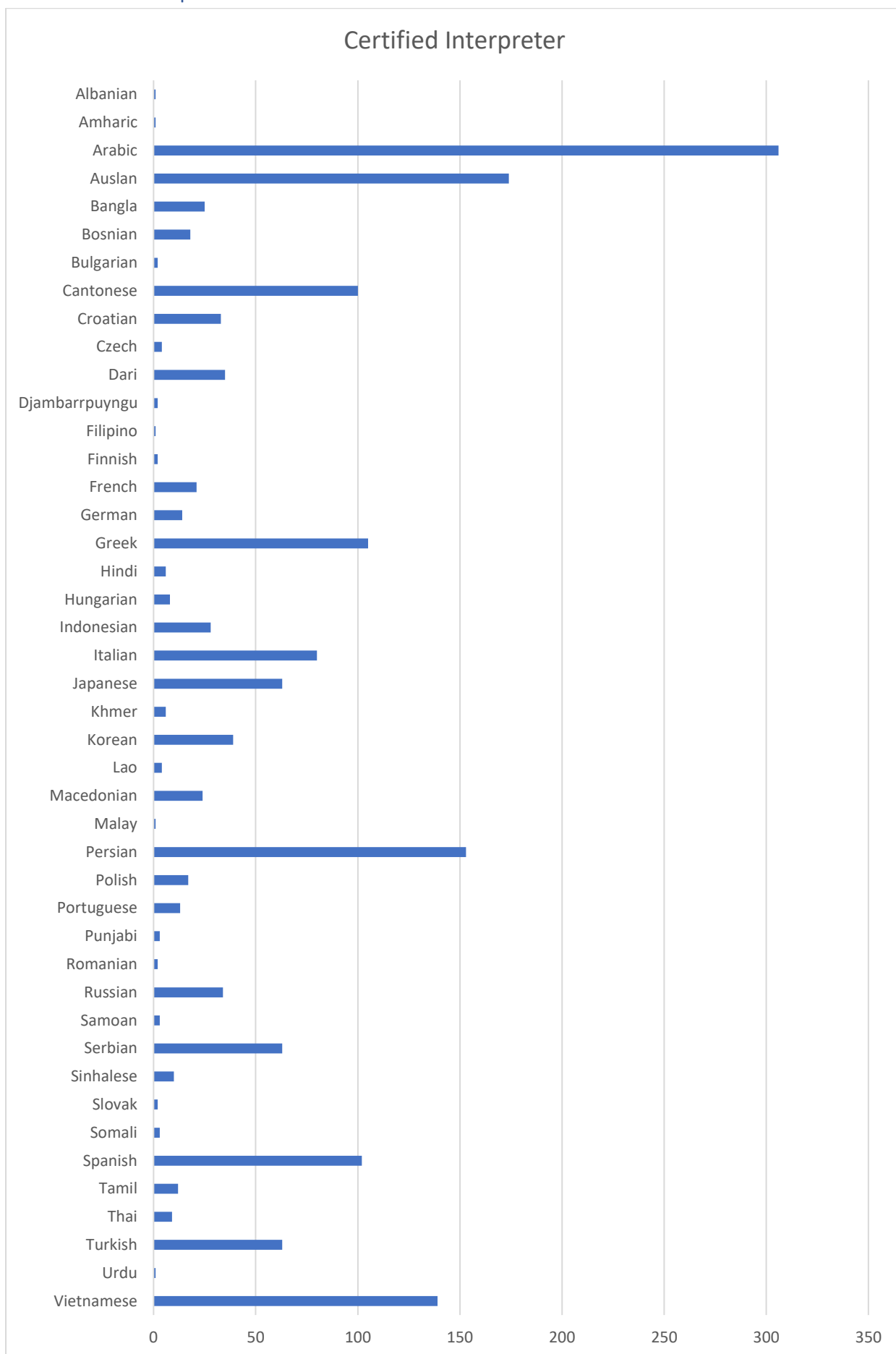
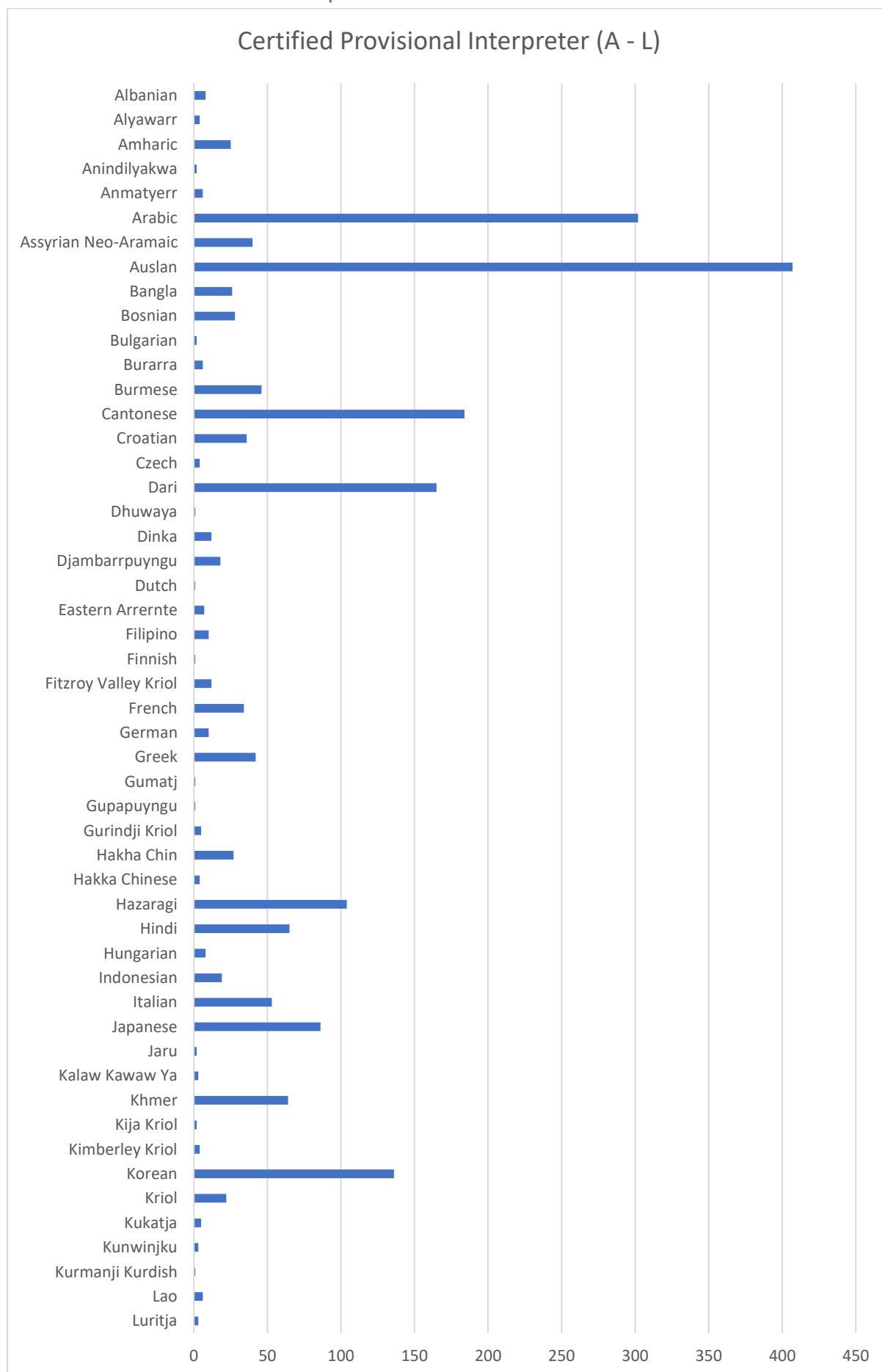


Figure 4 CI credentials

Certified Provisional Interpreter



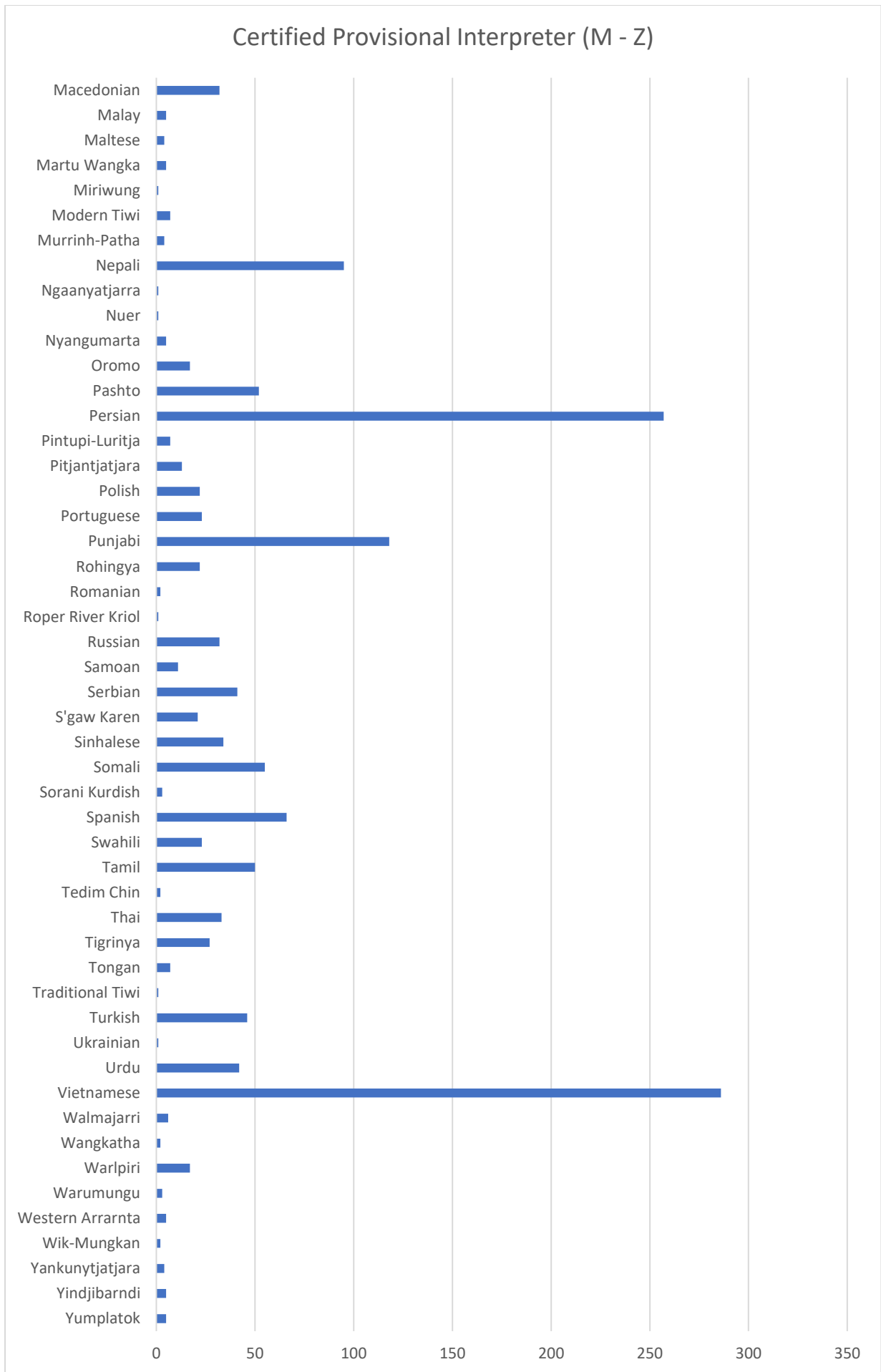
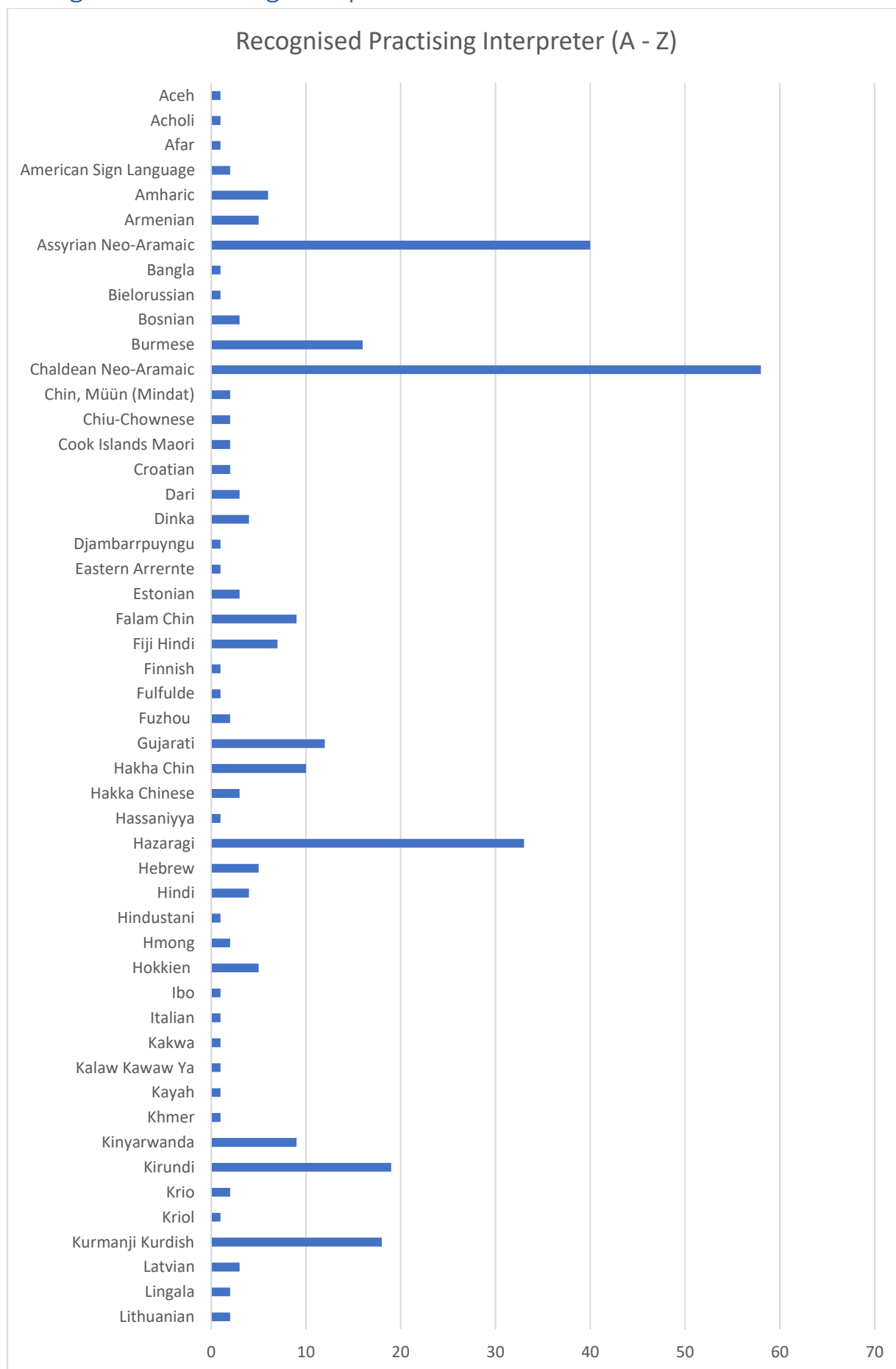


Figure 5 CPI credentials

Recognised Practising Interpreter



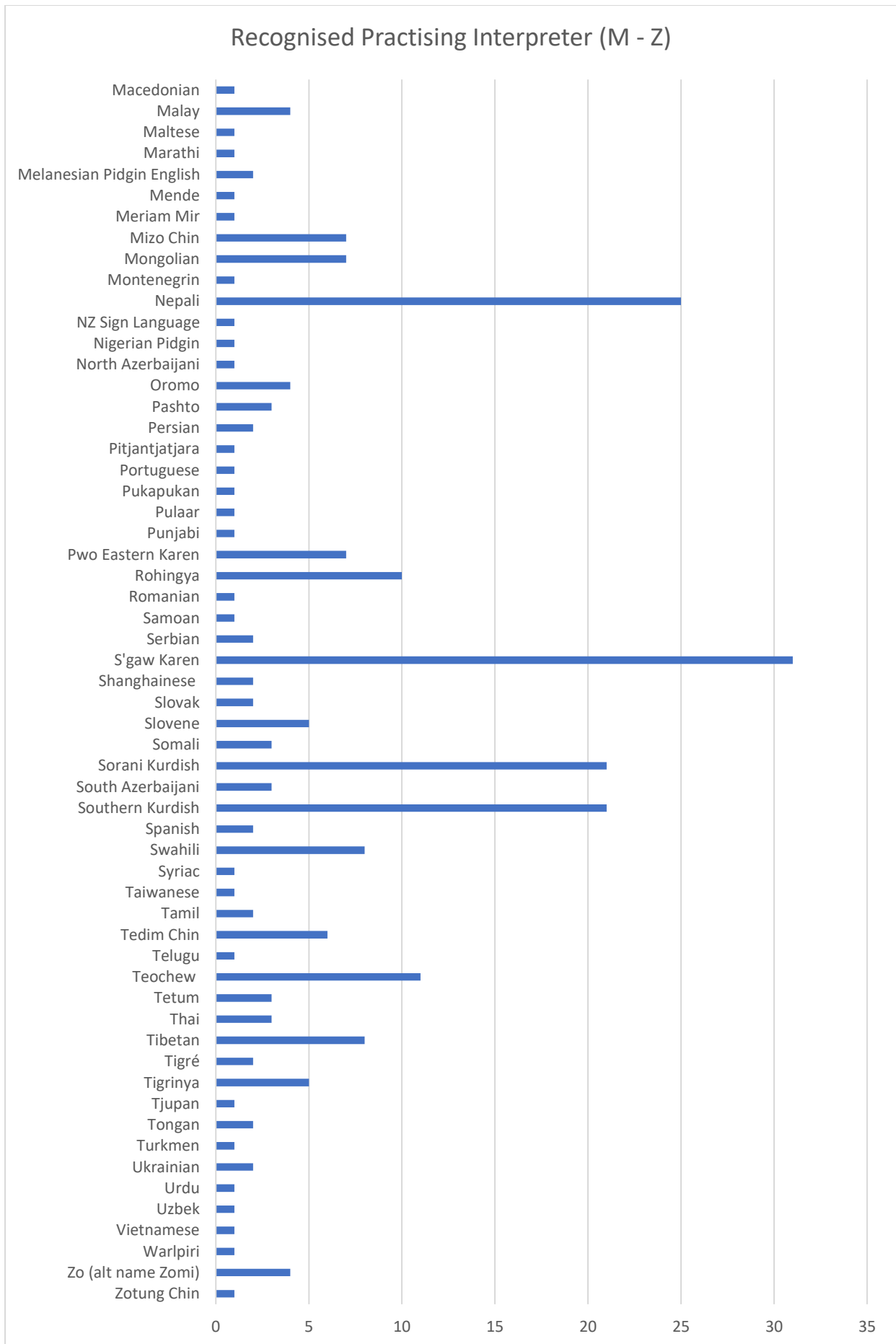


Figure 6 RPI credentials

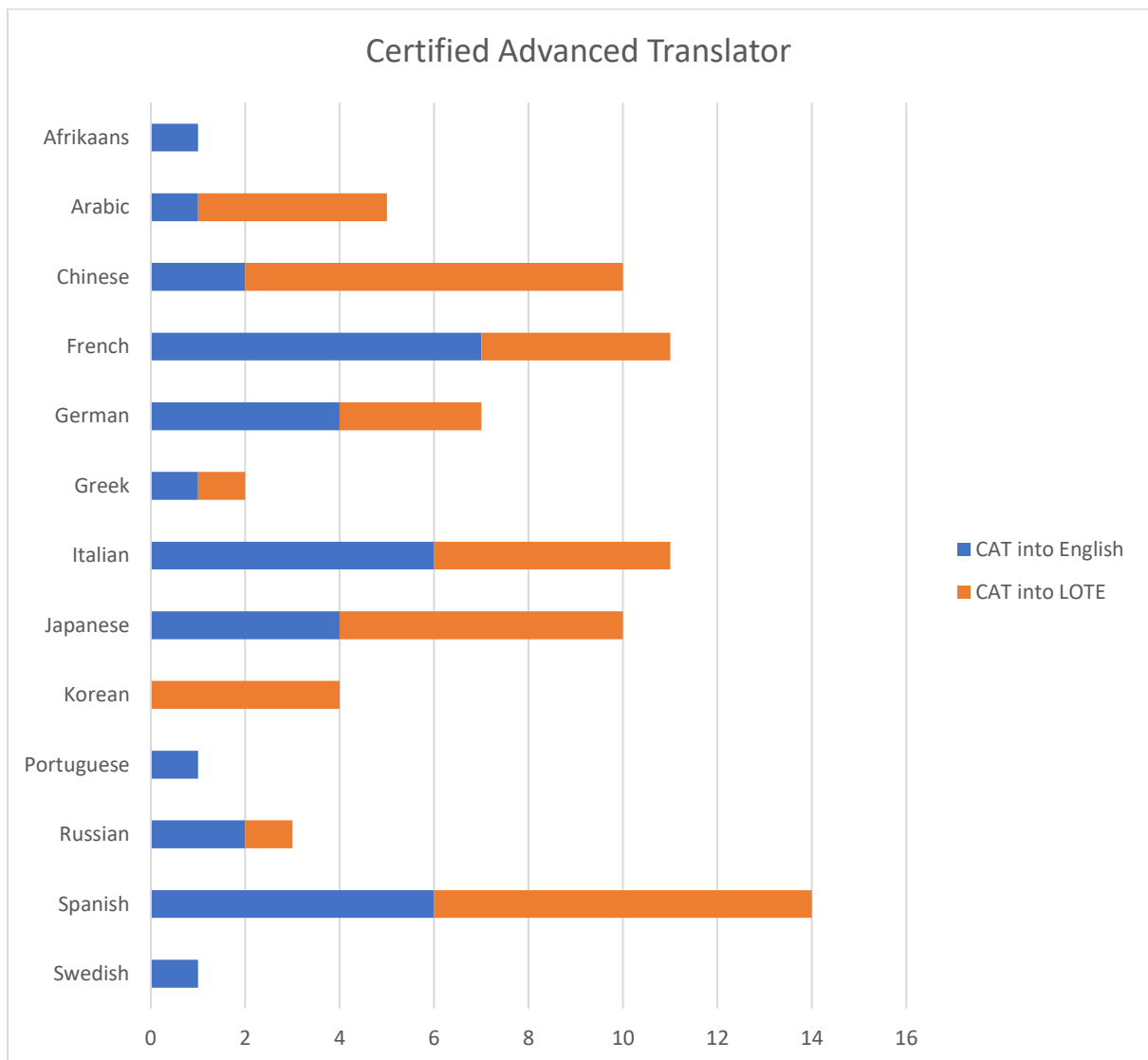


Figure 7 CAT credentials

Certified Translator

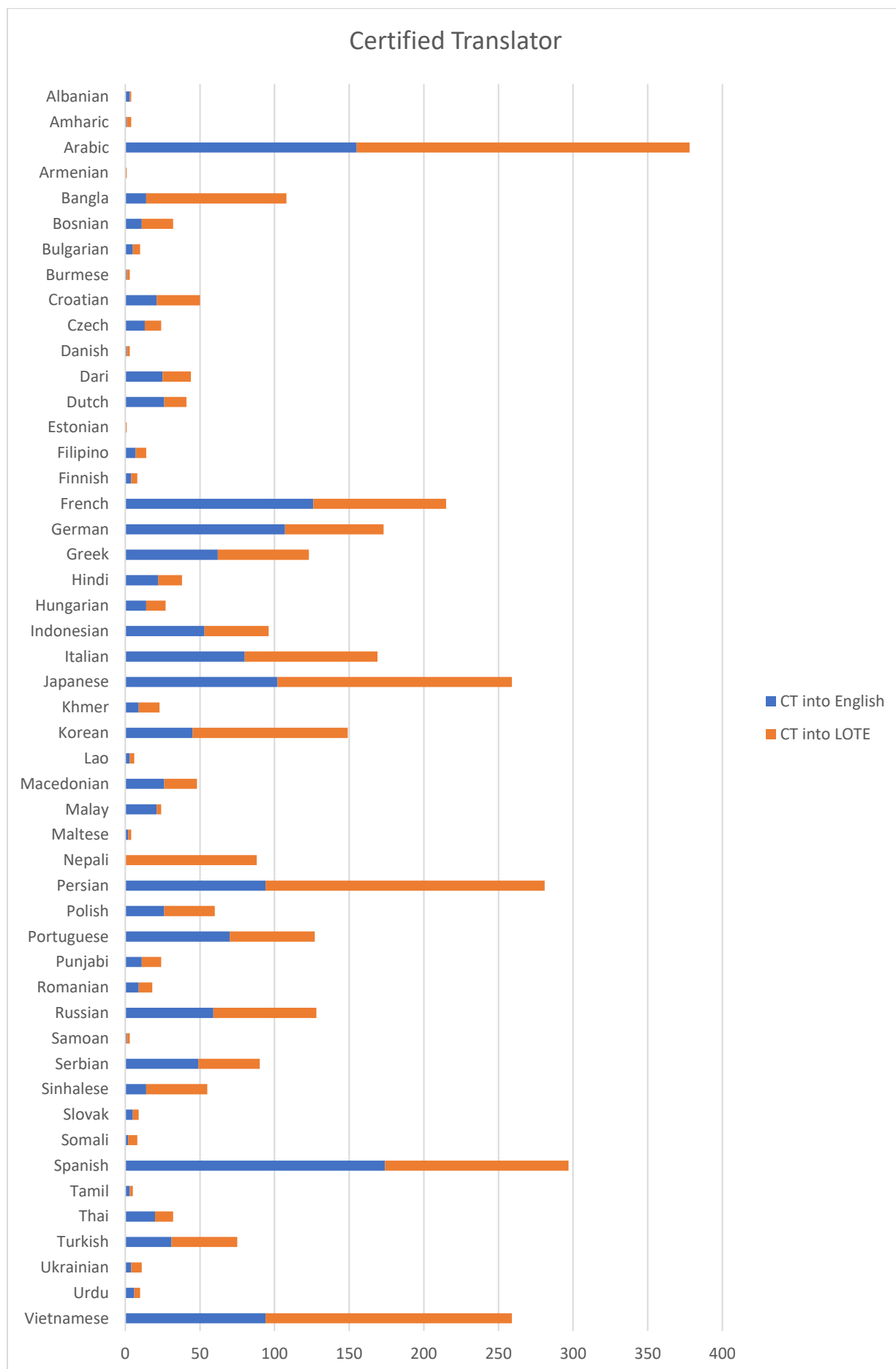
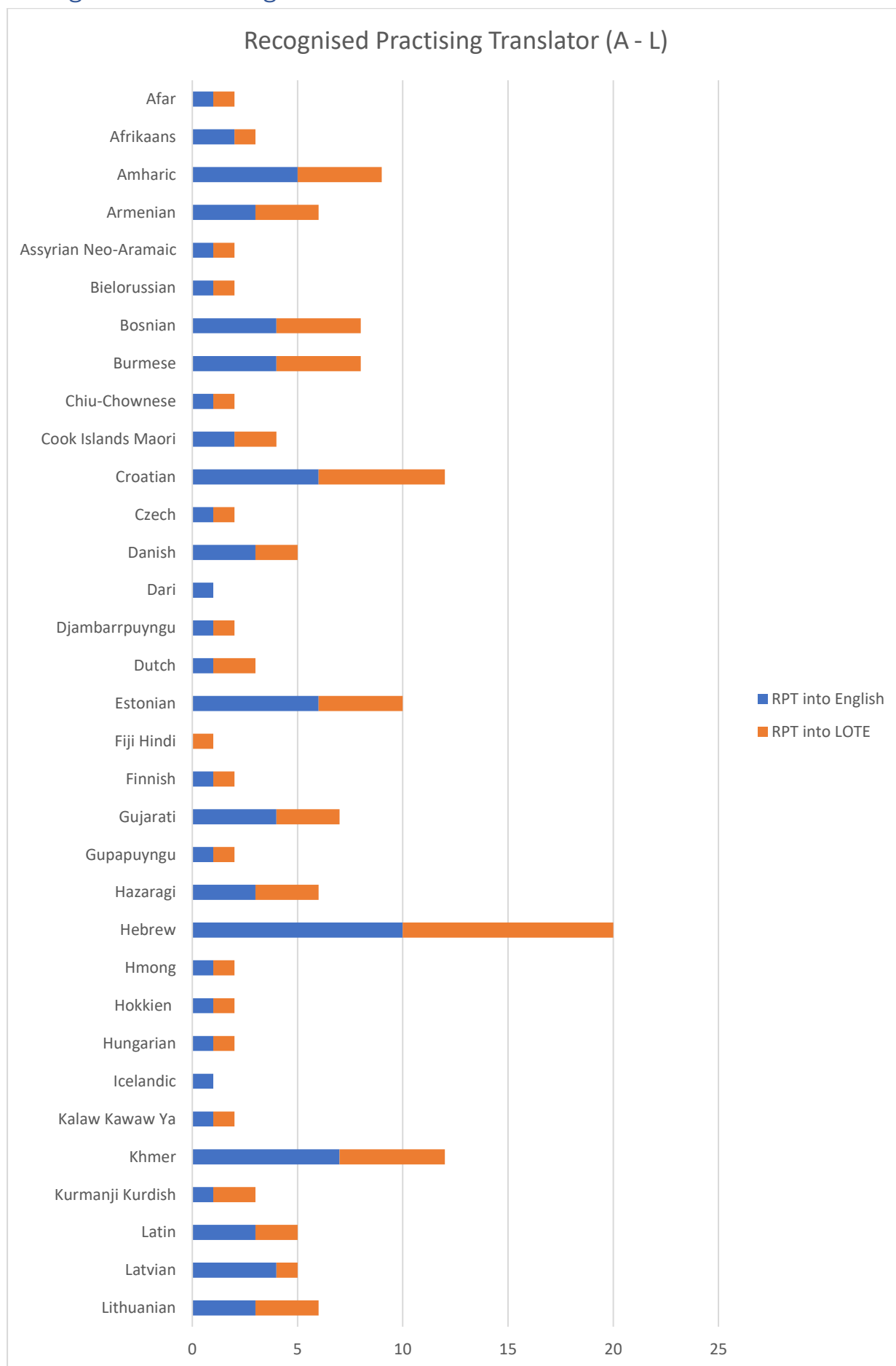


Figure 8 CT credentials

Recognised Practising Translator



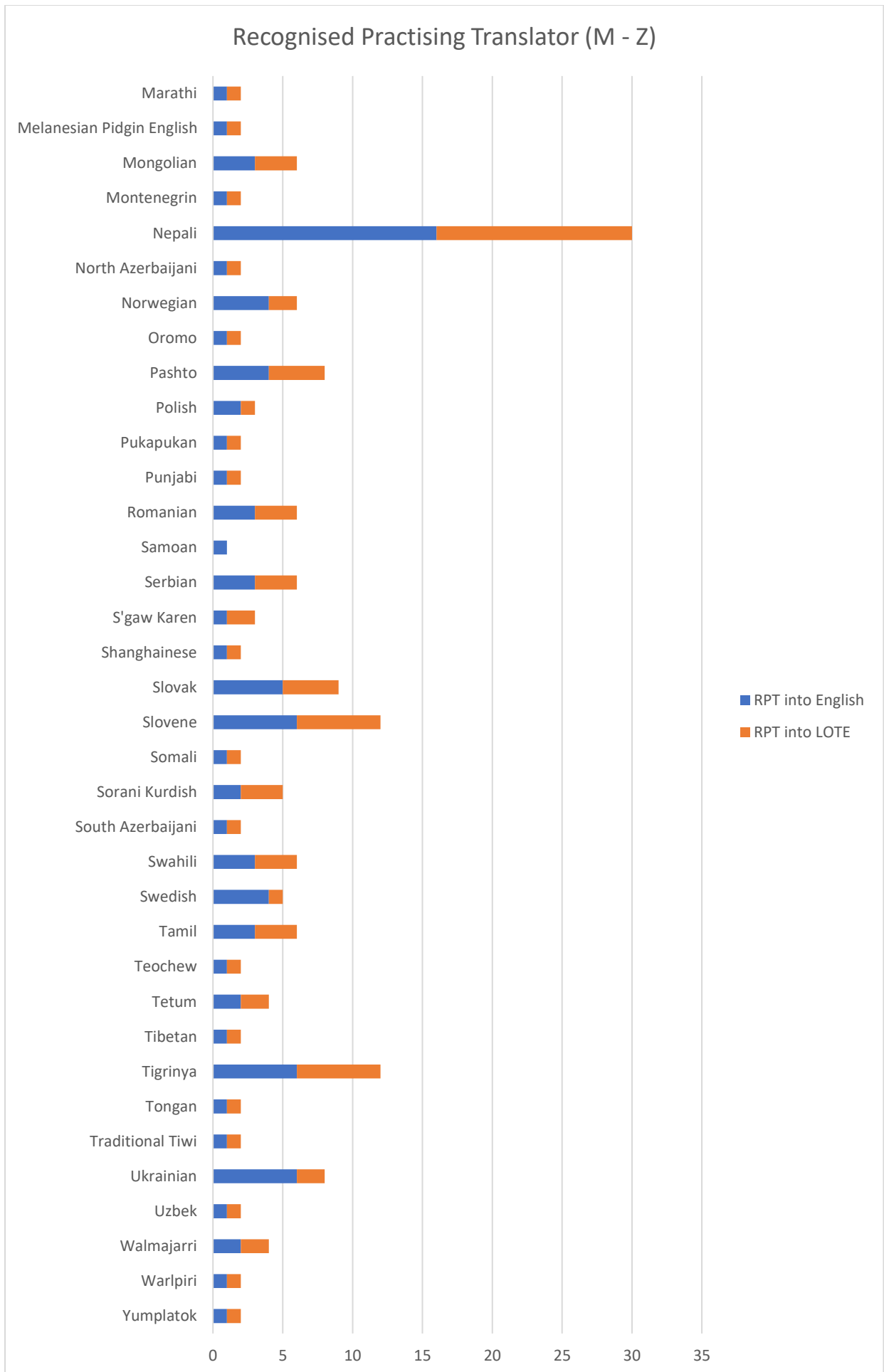


Figure 9 RPT credentials

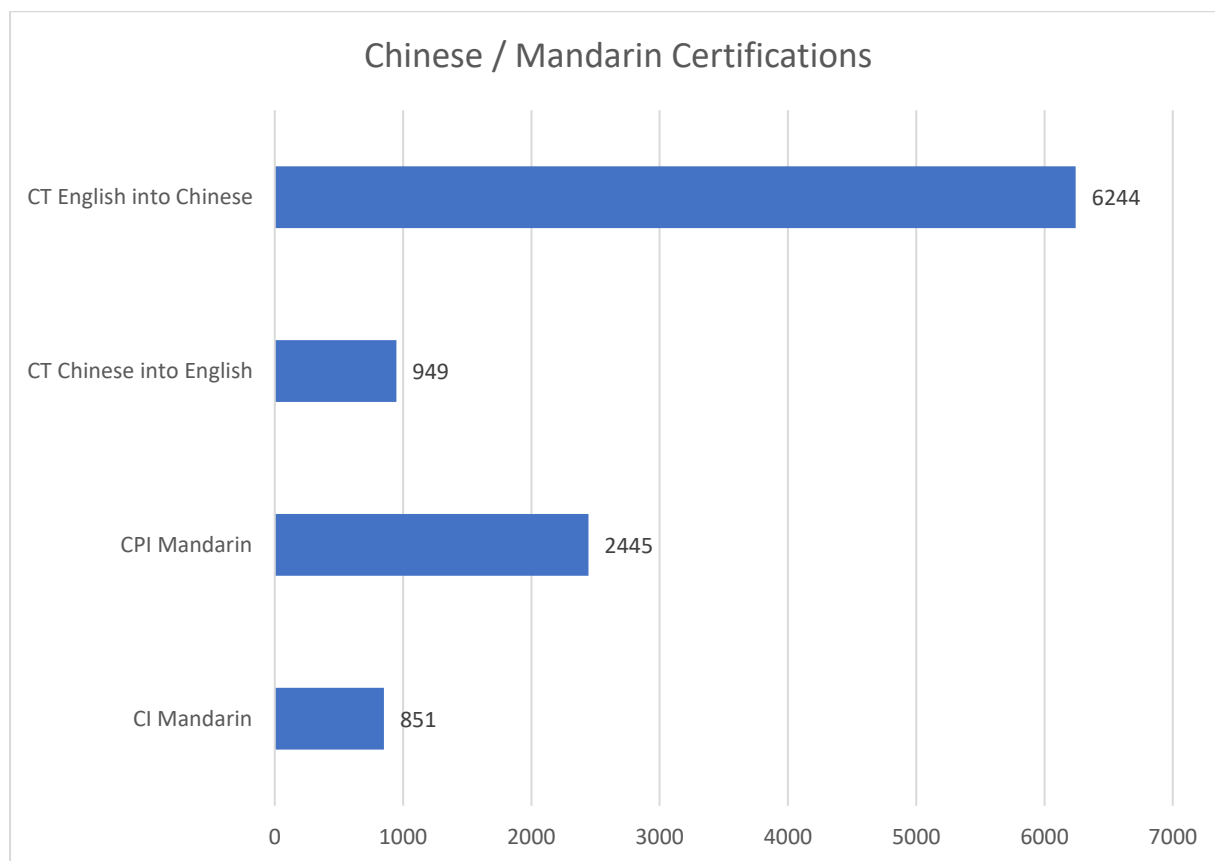


Figure 10 Chinese / Mandarin credentials

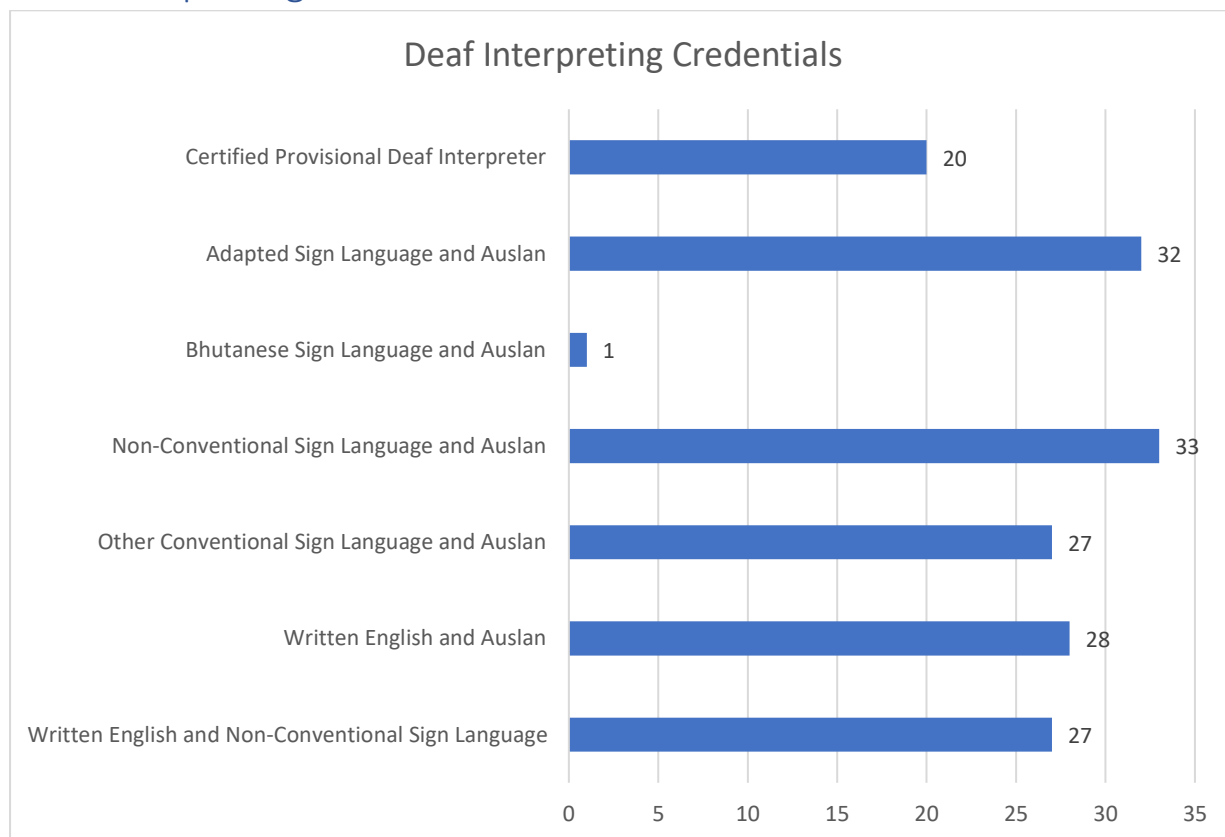


Figure 11 Deaf Interpreting credentials
